All Middle School Students

Middle School students will be required to have a laptop as part of their supplies for each

school year. Rivermont recognizes that students excel when they gain autonomy over their learning styles. This will also enable each student to bring a laptop that he/she is comfortable using, and have continuously, rather than returning a school device at the end of each year. Students will be expected to have their laptops with them- charged and ready for class on a daily basis.

Students may bring either a Windows or a Mac laptop. Windows laptops require at least a Windows 10.1 operating system. Mac laptops must have a minimum of the following operating system Version 10.11: “El Capitan”. Rivermont will provide all students, at no additional cost, a Microsoft Office 365 Business account that comes with 1 Terabyte of storage space and Office Software which is downloadable to their personal machine. Students will also have access to the Adobe Creative Suite applications- on school-owned computers, for classes that require it. Each device will need to be registered on our Wi-Fi system at the beginning of the school year in order to have Wi-Fi/ Internet access on campus. It is required that all the student-owned devices have anti-virus installed on them to be used within the school network. Windows provides a built-in solution but no matter what product is used it is required to be up to date on virus definitions and software version.

Chromebooks do not fit the needs/requirements the students will have for their academics.

Additionally, all Middle School Students will need:

- Paper (college ruled loose leaf)
- Individual pocket folders for EACH class taken
- Individual spiral notebooks for EACH class taken
- An ample supply of pencils and blue or black pens
- Calculator for math and science; drafting compass for science
- 2 containers anti-bacterial wipes (give to advisor)

- 1 pack markers and 1 glue stick (keep in locker)
- 2 boxes Kleenex (give to advisor)
- 1 USB/flash/jump drive, at least 4GB (8GB recommended) (label with name)
- 1 set earbuds
- 1 locker shelf (optional)
- It is recommended that each student have a Library card from local public library
