



Subject: Rivermont Collegiate Covid-19 update

Date: August 26, 2020

Dear Rivermont Families,

In the first days of returning to school, all students, faculty, and staff on campus had normal temperatures. We have collated, evaluated, and followed up on all Return to School In-Take Questionnaires.

On August 21, our full faculty participated in a Scott County Health-Rivermont workshop, which included responses to faculty questions.

**Prior to the opening of school on August 24**, in an abundance of caution and following our best health professional's advice, we required two faculty/staff members who had risk factors in their homes to quarantine and test for Covid-19. Neither faculty/staff member had contact with returning to school students on August 24, 25, 26, nor will have until the end of their quarantine period. One symptomless faculty/staff member continues to quarantine awaiting test results.

A second faculty/staff member and the family will remain in the full required quarantine period. I will be monitoring the family for symptoms. This staff member had no contact with any returning Rivermont students on August 24 or 25.
