



Subject: Sharing no-risk Covid-19 positive notification

Date: September 9, 2020

Dear Early School Parents,

In the interest of transparency and an abundance of caution, I am sharing with you that a member of the Rivermont Early School faculty/staff has tested positive for COVID-19; however, we can reassure you that no Rivermont faculty/staff/student was within the risk/exposure window. The faculty/staff member began experiencing mild symptoms on Tuesday of this week and was asked to stay home and take a Covid-19 test. According to Scott County Health guidance and due to the extended Labor Day weekend, no Rivermont student or faculty/staff are considered Covid-19 contacts of this person or are they considered at risk. We have asked the faculty/staff member to shelter at home for ten days starting from Tuesday in accordance to directives from Scott County Health and not return to the Rivermont campus or classroom until cleared to return.
