A Rivermont teacher has tested positive for Covid-19. The teacher maintained all of the Rivermont Covid-19 policies of masking, distancing, and hygiene while in the classroom.

As you know, Covid-19 can be asymptomatic or have a very mild single symptom that can be mistaken for allergies, etc. The teacher tested with a quick test after school out of a personal abundance of caution. The teacher will continue to quarantine but will take a PCR test for further confirmation.

According to the guidelines of the Scott County Health Department, no student was exposed; however, parents of students who were in this teacher's classroom on Tuesday, January 19, were contacted directly. No other students on this or previous school days were exposed.

Our cleaning crew routinely sanitizes classrooms, and in this case, did a deep clean on Tuesday evening. Going forward, all parents should monitor children for any illness symptoms as they normally would and contact me with any questions.
