

Social Distancing Policies and Procedures

Rivermont staff will follow CDC guidelines for summer camps. Refer to this link for more information:

TEACHERS

- All teachers will wear a mask or face shield when teaching.
- When within a 6 ft distance from students, teachers WILL wear a mask.
- Teachers will have temperature checks at the start of their shift. If a teacher's temperature is 100.0 or higher, they will be sent home without pay and may not return until they are fever-free without the use of fever-reducing medications for 24 hours.

STUDENTS

- Masks are REQUIRED for all students. Student should be kept home if they have a fever, cough, cold, gastro, etc.
- Hands will be sanitized often throughout the day. Hands will be sanitized upon entering the classroom, after any activities using supplies, upon exiting the classroom, before and after recess, etc.
- If students become ill during class, they will be separated until they are able to go home.
- Students should have sunscreen and bug repellent applied prior to arrival. Summer camp staff will assist students in applying these items, as needed. We will use spray sunscreen at camp and encourage students to rub it into their skin. *If your student needs a specific bug repellent or sunscreen, please label with his/her name, and we will keep it at school for their classes.
- Students must bring a reusable, spill-proof water bottle. They will NOT be able to drink from water fountains, but staff will assist them in refilling their bottles.
- Students must bring their own lunch and drink if they are enrolled in both sessions.
- Students may NOT bring any other items from home (toys, blankets, etc.) unless approved by staff.
- If students cannot maintain a healthy distance from others, they will be asked to sit out in the Director's office. Any behaviors that repeatedly place others in unsafe conditions may result in expulsion from summer camp.

FACILITIES

- Rooms and lunch areas will be cleaned following the CDC guidelines.
- Restrooms will be monitored by staff, when necessary, to ensure proper distancing and hand washing. Hands will also be sanitized when returning from the restroom.

DROP-OFF

Drop-Off Times

- AM Session: 8:15-8:30 a.m.
- PM Session: 12:20-12:30 p.m.
- Sports Camps: 3:20-3:30 p.m.

Drop-Off Procedures

- Due to added safety procedures, please allow extra time when dropping off students.
- Parents should check their student's temperature at home. Summer camp staff will check students' temperatures at their cars. If students' temperature is at 100.4 or higher, they will be sent home and will NOT be refunded that day's tuition. Students may not return until they are fever-free without the use of fever-reducing medications for 24 hours.
- Students will enter the building through open doors and proceed to their classrooms. Hands will be sanitized upon entering the classroom.

PICK-UP

Pick-Up Times

- AM Session: 11:30 a.m.
- PM Session: 3:30 p.m.
- Sports Camps: 5:00 p.m.

Pick-Up Procedures

- Students will be dismissed from classrooms and will await pick-up outside with social distancing in place. In case of rain, students will wait in classrooms for staff to dismiss them.
- Cars will park in the circle drive, and summer camp staff will dismiss the student.
- Students must walk directly to their car after sanitizing their hands.
- Summer camp staff will monitor pick-up at the circle drive to assist students and parents.

LATE POLICY

Please be prompt when picking up students. Habitual tardiness for drop-offs and/or pick-ups may result in removal from summer camp programs.
