RIVERMONT Summer Academies

2025 SESSION DESCRIPTIONS

ACT English & Reading Prep Academy

For those who plan to take the ACT (in addition to or instead of) the SAT, this course will help students prepare by teaching language usage and rhetorical skills, as well as providing ample practice with reading comprehension, with the goal of boosting the ACT subscores for the English and Reading sections. The class instructor is Ms. Julia Durango, Rivermont's Middle and Upper School English teacher and a published author.

ACT Math Prep Academy

For those who plan to take the ACT (in addition to or instead of) the SAT, this course will help students prepare by reviewing the algebra, geometry, and trigonometry concepts assessed by the math section of the ACT. The academy is led by Mr. Sangmin Park, Rivermont's math and computer science teacher and an expert in test preparation.

Acting & Improv Academy

This academy is for anyone who isn't afraid of being on stage. Students will play improv games, act out short skits, and gain comfort and confidence with vocal projection and nonverbal communication skills. The academy will be led by Mr. Hayden Richardson, a former theater kid himself.

Army Physical Training Academy (Weeks 5–8)

Want to build strength, speed, and stamina while also seeing if you have what it takes for the US Army? This academy is led by Mr. Hayden Richardson, who served in the army and will lead students in training exercises similar to the ones he followed during his time in service.

Cross Country Running Academy

This academy is designed for middle and high school students who intend to run cross country during the coming fall season. Each athlete will be provided developmentally appropriate workouts, building fitness over the course of the summer. Each day will include a warm-up, main workout, cool down, stretching, and light strength training. This academy will be overseen by Mr. Collin Lawrence, coach of the Rivermont cross country and track teams.

Crochet & Crafting Academy

For the artistically inclined, this academy will teach the art of crochet as well as other fun crafts. Students will learn techniques and crochet their own scarves, hats, or pouches. Advanced students can crochet stuffies or other more elaborate items. The academy is led by Mrs. Tiffany Johnson, who has taught crochet and supervised the knitting club for several years at Rivermont.

Esports Academy

Do you enjoy competitive gaming? Esports is one of the fastest-growing pastimes in the world. In the esports academy, students will engage in multiplayer games with peers, learning tips and tricks to improve their performance. The academy will be built around school-friendly games such as Mario Kart, Super Smash Brothers, FIFA, and Pokémon.

Fun With Code

For anyone who wants to learn about application development from idea to implementation. We'll explore how to plan your software project, how to structure your code, and finally put fingers to keys to actually build something that works. We'll work a web app and the tools to turn that into an app that runs on your laptop and mobile phone. No experience necessary, we'll start with the basics and build up from there.

Middle School Cooking/Baking Academy

Do you enjoy sweet treats? You'll enjoy them even more if you learn how to bake them yourself! This academy will teach students how to read and follow recipes while experimenting to create new taste sensations. Students will learn basic skills and principles of cooking and baking while making a variety of desserts. The class is strategically placed after lunch so that creations can be enjoyed as a mid-afternoon snack. Mrs. Tiffany Johnson, a Rivermont English instructor and avid baker, leads the class.

Podcast Production Academy

Do you enjoy having conversations about interesting topics? Have you ever listened to a radio story and wondered how it was produced? This academy is for you! Each week, students will pick a topic and spend time researching it. The students will then work collaboratively to produce a loose script and finally will create a record of their podcasts! The academy will be led by Mr. Will Brin, Rivermont's middle and upper school history instructor and a former podcaster.

RPG/D&D Academy

For students who enjoy playing Dungeons & Dragons and other role-playing games, this academy is for you. Fill out character sheets or army lists, paint miniatures, and engage in massive battles and grand adventures. The class is led by Mr. Hayden Richardson, an avid D&D player and Dungeon master.

SAT Math Prep Academy

The SAT Math Prep Academy offers a comprehensive learning experience, equipping you with various techniques and essential knowledge to tackle SAT math problems with confidence. Learn specialized methods crafted by Mr. Sangmin Park, Rivermont's math and computer science teacher and an experienced test prep instructor, designed to solve algebra and geometry problems efficiently—ensuring you can navigate these challenges effectively during the test. Mr. Park covers a range of topics, from fundamental algebraic operations to advanced trigonometric functions and statistics, emphasizing those that commonly appear in the test.

SAT Verbal Prep Academy

This academy is primarily designed for incoming sophomores, juniors, and seniors who plan to take the SAT (or PSAT) this coming year. The class will familiarize the students with the type of test questions asked, enhance student vocabulary, and provide lots of practice and feedback to help students improve their SAT verbal scores. The class instructor will be Ms. Julia Durango, Rivermont's Middle and Upper School English teacher and a published author.

STEM Academy

This academy is designed for middle and upper-level students who have a love for the sciences and the natural world around them. Students will learn about the mechanics guiding the world around them through discussion, observation, and experimentation. The group will engage in thrilling activities involving chemistry, physics, earth science, and biology! Exploding volcanoes, mouse-trap cars, dissecting frogs, and cracking open geodes are just some of the activities this academy has in store. The academy will be overseen by Mr. Hayden Richardson, Rivermont's Middle School Science Teacher.

Upper School Cooking Academy

In this academy, you will learn culinary science while preparing your lunch! Week 1 will focus on eggs, pasta, and custard. Week 2 will teach about beans, rice, and beef. Week 3 is American food. The course instructor is Dr. Scott Wellnitz, Rivermont science teacher and resident foodie.

Video Production Academy

Have you ever wanted to host your own YouTube channel but didn't know how? This academy teaches you how to plan and produce narrative videos, each week, built around a different theme. A laptop with a built-in camera is required for this academy. The academy will be led by Mr. Hayden Richardson, Rivermont's middle school science instructor.

Volleyball Academy

This academy is designed for middle and high school students who intend to play volleyball during the coming fall season or want to improve their volleyball skills. The class will be jointly led by Ms. Michelle Grimm, Rivermont's volleyball coach, and Mrs. Jill Beinborn, a coach of one of the Platform Elite teams.

Weird History Academy

Do you love learning about history and hearing crazy stories about the past? Weird History will introduce you to places and times far different from our own while also discussing the methods historians use to interpret the past. The academy will be led by Mr. Will Brin, Rivermont's middle and upper school history instructor.
