Dear Rivermont Community,

The Board approved the October 29 and November 21, 2025, meeting minutes following motions by Jasa and seconds by Drew and Greg. Jesse Davis provided a Parents' Council update, covering recent and upcoming events, communications, governance, and an upcoming election at the end of the school year. Leigh Ann's teacher report addressed initiatives such as a student YouTube page, faculty peer reviews, internet connectivity issues, and improving staff representation, alongside a broader discussion on elevating Rivermont to "best in class." Drew presented the development report, noting current campaign progress and highlighting key upcoming events, including Derby Day on May 2 and the Annual Gala on October 10, while emphasizing the need for full board participation in fundraising; Greg added that impactful programmatic and administrative changes are necessary for growth. Kristin reported that enrollment currently stands at 179, with 133 set to return and a goal of reaching 230 students by 2026, prompting discussion on outreach, attrition, and marketing strategies. Jill shared the communications report and proposed launching a Rivermont podcast, and the Interim Head report shared by Collin went over highlights of the recent months.
