Advanced Placement

Rivermont has been the top-ranked college Preparatory school in Iowa for every year of the Iowa AP Index (2005-2019) and achieved the highest AP Index score of all Iowa schools in eleven of sixteen years. In 2019 Rivermont Collegiate was ranked number one on the index; the index was not calculated in 2020-22 due to Covid. In 2025, Rivermont Collegiate was ranked number two on the index.

We are as strong in the STEM areas as we are in traditional courses, including constitutional studies, civics, and writing.
